



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When is the next Stoat Trappers' Ball?

A. On Saturday, 29th October, 2011, starting at 7.30pm

Q. Where will it be held this year?

A. At the beautiful Wainuiomata Golf Course club rooms on the banks of the Wainuiomata River (about a kilometre or so down the Coast Road at Wainuiomata.)

Q. What time should I get there?

A. Roll up any time after 7.30pm. The Band will play until around 11.30pm. Supper will be at around 9.00pm and it will all be over by midnight.

Q. What exactly IS the Stoat Trappers' Ball?

A. It is a hilarious fund-raising event for the **Rimutaka Forest Park Trust** which helps them to fund their stoat and rat trapping programme to protect their growing population of North Island Brown Kiwi (and other native birds/wildlife) in the Rimutaka Forest Park, near Wellington, New Zealand.

There's a fabulous live band (The Jimmies) and a tasty supper, plenty of dancing and fine music, lots of prizes to be won, plus an auction of highly desirable "goodies".

Q. Will it be fun?

A. Too right!! In fact it's guaranteed to be more fun than having a ferret up your trouser leg!

Q. What is the Dress Code?

A. Just about anything goes, but there will be prizes for the most imaginative or wacky outfits. Our dress code is best described as "Feral to Formal" – or "Bush to Glam...!"

Q. Do I have to wear a black tie?

A. Only if you think it goes well with your pink gumboots or knickerbockers...

Q. How much do the tickets cost?

A. Only \$30 for adults and \$20 for school-age children. (5 – 16) There is no charge for children under 5

Q. What is included in the price of the ticket?

A. Ticket prices cover Ball Entry, Supper, and as much fun as you can eat. Drinks (other than water, tea and coffee) are extra, but at "Club Prices"

Q. Will there be a lucky door prize?

A. Yes, all tickets are individually numbered and some lucky person will probably win a door...

Q. Will there be door sales of tickets?

A. Only if it's not entirely sold out beforehand!
(So don't count on it.)

A. Stoats are pesky little critters that greatly endanger our native birds and other wildlife. They are deadly predators of baby kiwi chicks and other small birds and their eggs.
